Below is a list of fee estimations based on baseline course material utilization. Course customization will incur fees or changes that would be clarified at time of quotation. These prices are reflective of starting points to host SOARescue under a contracted program.

- **Tactical Medical Practitioner:** \$44,400.00 / course
- **Extended Austere Provider:** \$46,800.00 / course
- **Rescue Medical Practitioner:** \$50,000.00+ / course
- **Technical Austere Medical Evacuation:** \$42,900.00 (with possible adjustment for flight hours/time)

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Q Can we meet the minimum with students from multiple departments?

A Yes. Open enrollment courses can draw students from neighboring departments. We can also help coordinate groups when multiple agencies have expressed interest.

Q What payment methods and terms are accepted?

A We accept check, credit card, and Purchase Orders. Net-30 terms available for government entities; private entities subject to approval. Multiple courses can be contracted upfront. Other contract vehicles available for federal purchasing.

Q Can we contract multiple courses at once?

A Yes — terms can be negotiated upfront and delivery can occur consecutively or at scheduled intervals, spreading travel costs across courses to reduce overall pricing.
